What is OECD?

OECD is made up of volunteer employer representatives who serve as advisors to the WorkSource Oregon Employment Department. There are 21 active employer councils throughout Oregon; operating independently to identify and assist with the needs of employers in their communities. There are no membership dues.

Locally we assist our employers by providing high quality low cost seminars; networking; at least \$2,400 in scholarships (this year \$4,000) at UCC; and \$1,500 per year in support dollars to local veterans. Also, OECD puts on a large Employer Expo/Job Fair every spring including time for high school students, since they are the workforce of the future.

Employers in good standing (attending at least 4 monthly meetings per year) receive discounts on OECD seminars, participate in our scholarship program, and have access to various resources, training videos and publications.

Partnering with the Roseburg Area Chamber of Commerce, OECD continues to be a community leader in improving the quality of employment and the workforce within Douglas County.
